When baazi.com came to know about they instantly removed it from their website. The crime branch of Delhi Police took cognizance of this matter and filed a charge sheet against the IIT student who listed the video on the website. Additionally, another charge sheet was filed, and the owner of the website was accused. The item was listed online around 8:30 PM on the evening of November 27th, 2004, and was deactivated around 10 AM on November 29th 2004. (Ghosh, 2008)

IV. NEW RULES FOR SOCIAL MEDIA, OTT AND DIGITAL MEDIA IN INDIA

In India, total WhatsApp users are 53 crores, total YouTube users are 44.8 crores, total Facebook users are 41 crores, total Instagram users are 21 crores, and total Twitter users are 1.75 crores in India as aforementioned by Ravi Shankar Prasad, Electronics and IT Minister of India.
